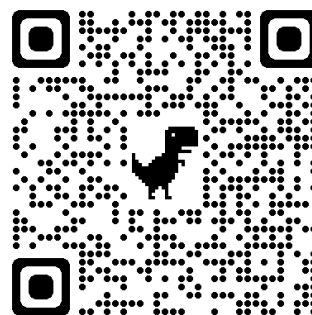

Route from Austria:

From Vienna toward Budapest A4 continue E60, on M1 take exit 129 for 85 toward Győr Centrum, turn right onto 85 toward Győr Centrum, then turn right onto 1, after 1,2 km turn right onto Ikrény, after 2,5 km when You came above the highway on the left there is the lake.

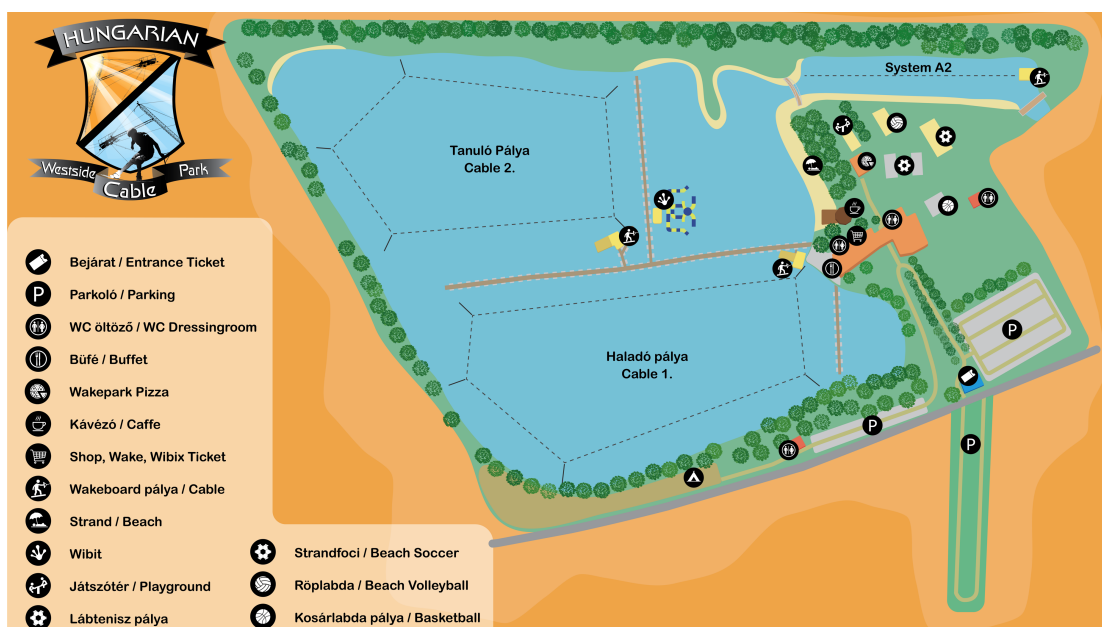


Lodging and restaurant at the cable:

There are two buffets in the area, one serves hot sandwiches, fried and grilled foods, salads and drinks, in the other buffet you can have pizza and lángos (Hungarian specialty made by deep-frying a basic dough). There is also a pavilion café, where you can buy coffee, ice coffee, drinks, lemonades and smoothies.

There is no accommodation provided in the area, however there is a place for camping, where it is possible to set up tents, or stay in an RV, caravan. Details are further down in the bulletin.

WEST SIDE CABLE PARK MAP

There are 3 cables on the lake. One works counter clockwise, the other one is clockwise and the third one is a 2 tower straight line system.

Cable Nr.1 starts right, ideal for advanced riders with lots of obstacles.
/Competition cable park/

- 5 mast
- 722 m long
- 9 carriers
- counter clockwise, starts right
- 30km/h speed
- usually has 11 obstacles
- Rope length 17.90m

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- Provisional features plan

Cable Nr.2 starts left, for the beginners it goes slower (24-27 km/h) almost all day.

Cable Nr.3 Two towers system is perfect for beginners who have never wakeboarded before. It's also an invaluable tool for riders learning their first inverts to be more experienced with more advanced tricks.

4. - RULES

• AGE CATEGORIES

U14: (14yrs or Under), Boys & Girls:

The last year a rider is allowed to compete in this category is the year of their 14th Birthday.

(For 2023, it means the rider has to be born between 2009 – 2012, but they must have reached their 11th birthday by registration day of the competition 28.08.2023).

U18: (18yrs or Under), Junior Men & Women:

The last year a rider is allowed to complete in this category is the year of their 18th Birthday.

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(For 2023, it means the rider has to be born between 2005 – 2012, but they must have reached their 11th birthday by registration day of the competition)

+30: Masters Men & Women:

The first year a rider is allowed to compete in this category is the year of their 31st Birthday.

(For 2023, It means the rider must be born in 1992 or before).

+40: Veterans Men and Women:

The first year a rider is allowed to compete in this category is the year of their 41st Birthday.

(For 2023, it means the rider must be born in 1982 or before).

To clarify: a rider born in 2012 can compete in U14 or U18. It is the same for +30 & +40: a rider born in 1982 can choose to compete in +40 or +30

• **OPENING A CATEGORY**

For this event there will be a minimum of 6 riders required to open a category, with the exception of +30 Women, +40 Men and Women & U18 Wakeskate where 4 riders are required.

In both cases, at least three different nationalities will be required to open a category.

The organiser will inform all participating Federations as soon as feasibly possible if there are insufficient riders within a category.

• **RANKING POINTS**

Minimum requirements: are 800 points for U18 & +30, and 400 points for all other categories on the rolling CWWC World Ranking list the day the competition starts.

Additionally, each Federation can enter max. 2 riders per gender per category with no minimum requirements (wildcard).

A Rider can only use one wildcard per competition. (ie they cannot use a Wildcard for Wakeboard and Wakeskate – they can only ride in one)

The minimum number of points can be reached by adding points from higher categories, as follows:

- U14 can add points from U18 and Open to be able to start in U14
- U18 can add points from Open to start in U18
- +30 can add points from Open to start in +30
- +40 can add points from +30 and Open to start in +40

5. - ENTRY AND ADMINISTRATION

Entry fee per athlete:

U14 Category & U18 Category - €230

+30 Category & +40 Category - €280

Entry must be made by your federation on cablewakeboard.net (instructions added as an appendix at the end of the document), and payment should be made via Bank Transfer by the Federation for the WHOLE TEAM (No individual payments to be made)

The Federation making the transfer should pay all the transfer fees associated with the payment.

Payments on site will only be accepted for Team Training.

ENTRY DEADLINES:

Entries must be confirmed by the Federations on Cablewakeboard.net no later than MONDAY 24th JULY 2023.

Late Entry Fees apply from 00:00 (CET) on 25th July 2023.

Late Entry Fee is €10 per athlete per day that they have not been ticked as approved by the Federation on Cablewakeboard.net.

Federations – Please ensure you understand the process for approving team athletes before this deadline, as late entry fees will apply if you have not contacted us in advance. (Contacting us on the 24th or later will not waive the late entry fee.

For RIDERS from countries without a Federation, please contact the IWWF Cable Wakeboard Council well in advance so that we can explain the process for entry. (In some cases, Double Entry Fees may apply, but there are also limits to the number of riders allowed to compete)

PAYMENT FOR TEAM ENTRIES MUST BE MADE BY: MONDAY 14th AUGUST 2023

Federations not making payment by this date will incur a LATE PAYMENT FEE of €500

Athletes will not be able to compete until the Late Payment fee has been paid.

Payment must be made for all athletes that have been marked as approved by the federation. If athletes are not able to compete after being approved the federation must contact the Technical Delegate of the competition at the earliest opportunity. Fees will only be returned under exceptional circumstances and accompanied by relevant documentation.

REGISTRATION:

RIDERS - Before the Event:

- **You need to be member of your national federation and have their licence.**
- Register on www.cablewakeboard.net yourself BEFORE 24th JULY 2023
- Register yourself for the championship.
- Ask your federation to approve you for that event. BEFORE 24th JULY 2023
- Make sure you pack your passport, and have it available on site during the competition, and give it to your team captain for registration.
- Remember your personal accident insurance and ensure it covers you to compete at the event.

At the Event:

Registration will happen on Wednesday 28th August.

From 9am – 4pm

Team Captains will be given a time slot for their team registration. If they miss this time slot, then they will have to wait until the registration team are ready to process them. Teams that are ready at their given time slot will be given priority for registration.

The Team Captain is responsible for registering the WHOLE team, there is no individual registration process.

If the Team Captain is missing a rider's information, then they will have to wait until the last team are registered to complete their registration. If documents are missing, then the rider will not be able to compete, and no refunds will be made for entry fees paid.

- The Team Captain will need to collect all Riders Passports and Insurance Documents prior to registration
- The Team Captain will produce all the passports to the Registration team, who will check DOB's and Nationalities against the passports.
- The registration Team will also ask to see the athlete's personal accident insurance and check an indemnity form has been completed (waiver)
- Once the Insurance/passports & waivers have been checked, the registration team and Chief Scorer will check that the athletes either have the required points for competing or the team are within the allowance for wildcards.
 - U14/+40 – Require 400 Ranking Points
 - U18 + 30 – Require 800 Ranking Points
- The registration team will also ask to see proof of payment for the team, so please bring a copy of the bank transfer. For any teams that decided to wait to transfer the team entry please be aware that the transfer amount will need to include the late payment fee of €500.
- Team Training will need to be paid during registration, this will have been calculated by the Chief Scorer and should be paid on site in Cash (€) It is not possible to provide this information earlier, as we do not know until 24hrs prior to training how many riders will be on each session.

6. - PRACTICE AND PUBLIC RIDING HOURS link

PUBLIC HOURS, CABLE BOOKINGS, RENTAL HOURS

Public hours for riders before the competition (until August 28th):
riders can come earlier to practice in the public hours or to stay longer.
This is paid directly to the cable park.

RENTAL HOURS FOR TEAMS, 4 DAYS BEFORE COMPETITION -August 25th to 28th) - (PAID AT the cable during registration in CASH €)

Federations can book rental hours for teams online for the four days before: 25th - 28th Between 8.00 - 12.00 and 18.00 - 19.30

250 euros/hour. Or 125 euros/30minutes

Team Training can only be booked by the Team Captain or authorised Federation Member on Cablewakeboard.net.

Paid on site at Registration. More than one team can share the slot and share the cost.

Teams are allowed to book a maximum of 6 - 30 minute slots.

7. OFFICIAL TRAINING

August 29th

As always, each country will have the training times calculated by number of riders. The final schedule by country will be published on cablewakeboard.net in the evening after the registrations are done.

Please give the Registration team and scorers time to finish registration and allocate times properly. They have a lot to check and want to make sure everything is accurate.

Training on the official practice day is included in the entry fees.

8. - DOPING CONTROL

For DOPING Controls you need to have a National/International valid **passport**. In line with the IWWF Doping Rules, Doping controls will be conducted during the competition.

By entering this competition, all athletes agree to be subject to doping control.

RIDERS - Please always have your ID with you during the competition or ensure your team captain or team support have it.

9. SAFE SPORT

Please be aware of the IWWF Safe Sport Guidelines.

The IWWF believes that all athletes, staff, and volunteers have the right to participate and develop in sport, in a safe and inclusive environment, free from all forms of discrimination, abuse, violence, neglect and exploitation. For young people, these rights are paramount.

The IWWF is committed to devising and implementing policies to ensure that everyone within the broader remit of the organization accepts their responsibility to attempt to safeguard athletes and participants from harm and abuse by following procedures designed to safeguard them and reporting any concerns about their welfare through established pathways.

Please be aware that: All minors must be accompanied on site by a responsible adult. It is not acceptable to send a minor to the event without a guardian, local social services will be contacted to act in loco parentis if this occurs. IWWF Officials will not take on this role.
