The Park

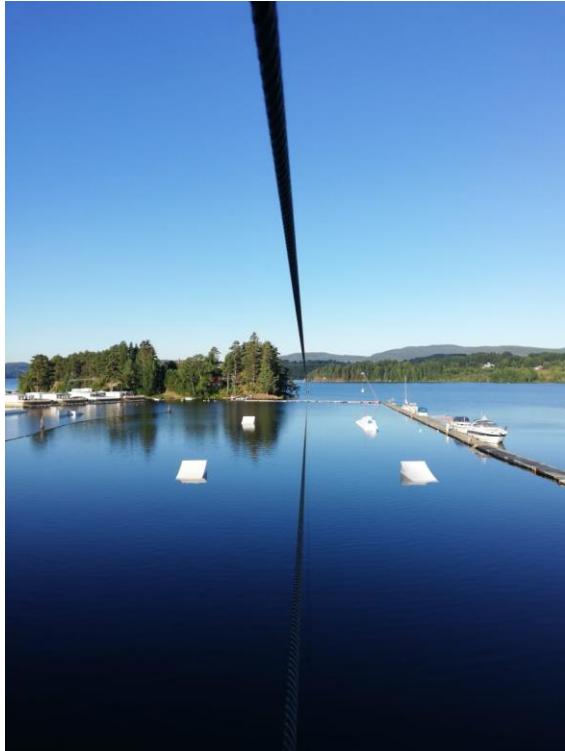
Norsjø Cable Park is located in the middle of Norsjø Ferieland, which is one of Norway's best caravan parks.
