The IWWF Bye-Law 16.1 states:

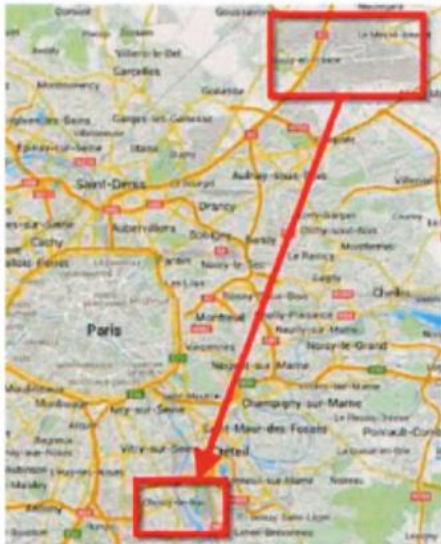

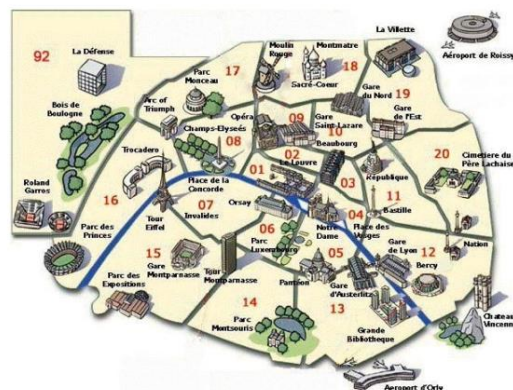

Federations and Riders are requested to make their own way to the Cable.

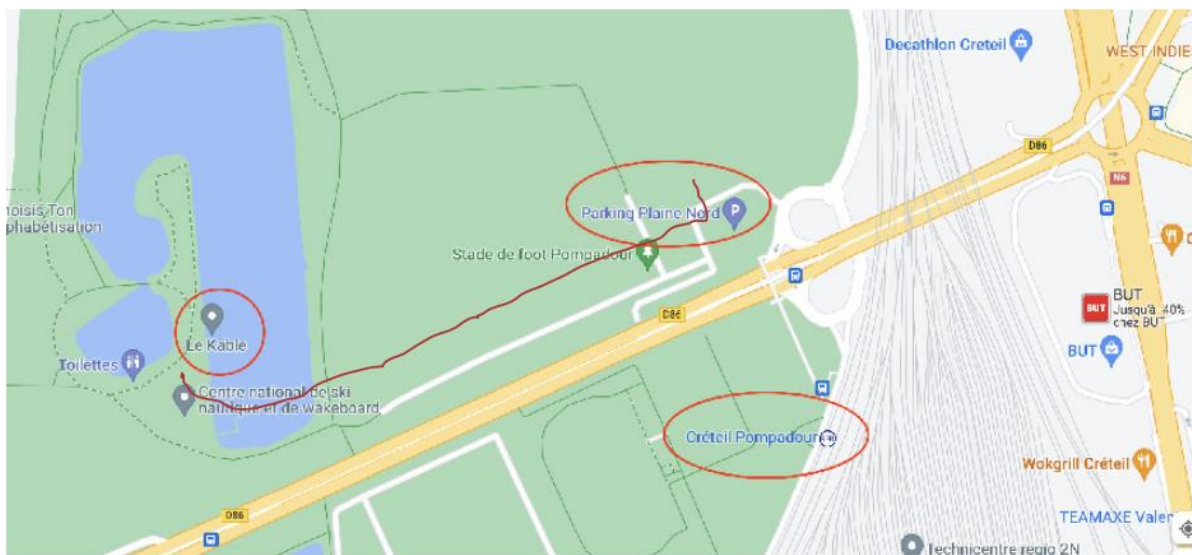

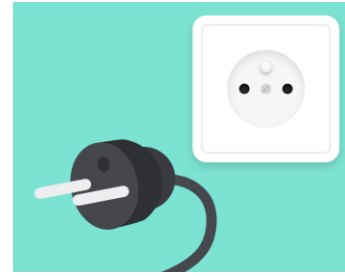

The IWWF takes safeguarding extremely seriously and is committed to ensuring that everyone who attends the championships, whether athletes, officials or volunteers are able to operate in a safe environment, free from abuse and the risk of harm. It is a condition of participation that all attendees familiarise themselves and comply with the IWWF Safeguarding Regulations which are available at <https://iwwf.sport/safe-sport-information/>

13. LIABILITY

The Fédération Française de Ski Nautique et de Wakeboard , the IWWF and the organizing committee of the 2024 IWWF World Cable Wakeboard & Wakeskate Championships, do not accept any liability for damage to persons, materials or property against competitors, technical officers, judges, official helpers and other persons. All competitors take part at their own risk in every respect even if they are engaged out of the competition, e.g. in any additional program. With their entry in the competition, they give up any claim for instances of loss of any kind arising indirectly or directly during this event. Participants should take out private accident insurance besides their health insurance. Damage to third parties (eg. spectators) is insured only within the limits of the organizer's liability. Participants will be required to sign a waiver upon registering and **provide evidence of adequate personal accident insurance that covers you in**

competition. In the event that a rider does not have insurance, he can subscribe to the French Federation's license for foreign participants at a special rate of 20€: payable in situ by cash or credit card.

14. EVENT RULES

All Federations, team managers, team captains and riders should be familiar with the current [IWWF Cable Wakeboard & Wakeskate Rules](#).

14.1 SELECTION

It is the sole responsibility of [IWWF-affiliated National Federations](#) to select and enter their riders.

Only riders born before 15th September 2013 can participate in the 2024 IWWF World Cable Wakeboard & Wakeskate Championships

14.2 MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS AS OF YEAR 2024:

Each Federation can enter maximum 2 riders per gender per category with no minimum requirements (these riders are referred to as 'wildcards'). Additional entries must meet the following ranking point requirements, on the current [IWWF Cable Wakeboard & Wakeskate Ranking list](#), at the time the competition begins. The entry requirements for the 2024 World Championships are 800 points for U18, Open and +30, and 400 points for all other categories on the rolling CWWC World Ranking list the day the competition starts.

The minimum number of points can be reached by adding points from higher categories, as follows:

- U14 can add points from U18 and Open to be able to start in U14
- U18 can add points from Open to start in U18
- +30 can add points from Open to start in +30
- +40 can add points from +30 and Open to start in +40

14.3 FEDERATION MEMBERSHIP

All riders must be members of their respective country's IWWF affiliated [National Federation](#).

How it works: IWWF has a network of [+90 National Federations](#).

Only IWWF-affiliated national federations can submit entry forms for the IWWF World Championships. By entering riders for the IWWF World Championships, national federations certify that their respective riders hold a valid membership and insurance policy (which provides international coverage).

Each national federation selects its team and decides on allowing the individual entries. If you are not sure how it works in your country or how to locate your respective National Federation, please contact us and we will provide information.

Exceptions: Riders from countries without a national wakeboard/waterski federation affiliated to the IWWF will be permitted to register to compete in the IWWF World Championships, subject to approval from the IWWF. Please contact us for more information.

14.4 SAFETY

Please note that all riders have to wear helmet and an approved life vest. All participants ride/compete at their own risk.

14.5 Athletes Under 18 years of Age

IWWF Cable Wakeboard Council & Officials follow the [IWWF Safe Sport Policy](#). All athletes under the age of 18 years, must be accompanied at the site by a guardian over the age of 18 years. This guardian will accept parental responsibility for the athlete for the duration of the competition. The IWWF and its officials DO NOT act in loco parentis for any child at an event.

15. ENTRY DEADLINES

Each Federation shall submit their Riders' entry on cablewakeboard.net by Friday 16th August 2024. Full payment of entry fees is to be received by IWWF (details below) No Later than Friday 23rd August 2024. No rider will be able to start in the competition if there are any fees outstanding.

If one of your riders is injured and you wish to replace them with a new rider, you will not have to pay Late Entry fee for the replacement rider. No refunds will be made for riders' non-attendance.

15.1 Entry Form

Each Federation shall submit an Entry Form online at the IWWF World Cable Wakeboard Council website cablewakeboard.net latest 16th August 2024. Any Federation not meeting this requirement will not be allowed to compete until the Federation pays a fine of USD10.00 per rider per day after this deadline to the IWWF for each rider not officially entered. Late entries will only be accepted with the mutual consent of the Organizer and Technical Delegate.

15.2 Fees

The Entry Fee will be USD250.00 per rider if competing in the Under 14 and Under 18 categories, and USD275.00 per rider if competing in the Seated, Open, Over 30 and Over 40 categories. This includes the IWWF International License and riders should NOT be registered on the IWWF EMS System for this event. Entry fees must be paid by bank transfer to FFSNW (details at point 20). The deadline for payment is 23rd August 2024. Please indicate your "Name of Country" and "Entry Fee 2024 IWWF Cable Wakeboard Worlds" when making your transfer. An email with a copy of the bank transfer receipt must be to be sent to: office@cablewakeboard.net

15.3 Late Entry Fees

The only payment that will be accepted on site at registration, is payment for Late Entry fees charged at USD\$10.00 per day (Max charge USD\$440.00 per rider). All entry fees MUST be made by Bank Transfer to FFSNW.

- Before a Federation can register a rider to compete, the rider has to register online at www.cablewakeboard.net and join the competition.
- After a rider joins the competition, the Federations will need to login at this [link](#) to approve the rider.

16.3 REGISTRATION CHECK LIST

Team Captain's should ensure their riders have in hand / completed the following before reporting for registration:

16.3.1 Completed all **profile fields** when they register online (to verify, please click on the rider's link on the online entry form) at <http://www.cablewakeboard.net/>

16.3.1.1 Uploaded a **profile photo** in the first slot (the first photo will be displayed on the TV Monitors during the event)

16.3.1.2 Completed/submitted a declaration/waiver /release form (Online)

16.3.1.2.1 [Form for Minors](#) (signed by their Parents or. legal Guardian)

16.3.1.2.2 [Form for Adults](#)

16.3.1.3 [Anti-Doping Consent Form](#) (has to be signed by the Parents or Guardian if under 18 years of age)

16.3.2 Valid passport to show proof of age and nationality (ID Cards and driving licenses are insufficient proof)

16.3.3 Proof of Personal Accident Insurance – to include participation in this competition

Once all riders have completed the above steps, the Team Captain should report to registration with all passports, forms and proof of payment to complete registration.

17 RIDERS REPRESENTATIVE ELECTION

RIDERS Representative elections will take place during the championships, further details will be sent out explaining the process through our social media channels.

18 OFFICIAL TRAINING – Monday 16th September 2024

Each country will be allocated training times based on the number of riders on their team. The final schedule by country will be published in the evening after the registrations are done.

19 TEAM TRAINING

All Riders will start training together during the Rental Hours and are required to book training slots.

- Training slots are available from 10th to 13th September from 9:00 am – 12:00 pm (3 hours per day for 4 days)
- Each country has 6 credits to book 6 different training slots
- Slots are 30-minute sessions, USD125.00 per session.
- Any number of teams can enter a slot.
- You can use all 6 credits before Friday, but only 4 on Friday.
- The deadline for bookings is 6:00 pm the day before.
- You can only book with a full team of riders who have registered to compete in the event.
- You must pay for the number of slots booked at registration
 - Fees must be paid in Cash at Registration
 - Fees are payable for all slots booked regardless of whether they are used.
 - Fees will only be calculated at registration as it is not possible to work this out in advance due to teams having the ability to change booked slots up until the evening before.

20 OFFICIAL FUNCTIONS

The Opening Ceremony, Closing Ceremony & Final Night Party are offered free of charge to Athletes, Team Officials, Technical Officials, IWWF World Wakeboard Council Members and IWWF Executive Board Members. The venue for the Opening Ceremony will be advised in Bulletin 2, Closing Ceremony & Final Night Party will be on site at the Wake Park. The cost for Friends/Family/Supporters to attend both functions will be on sale up at the Organiser's Office at event venue.

21 LUNCHES ON SITE

29 THE WORLD GAMES 2025

Next year marks a historic milestone as cable wakeboarding returns to the prestigious stage of the World Games after a two-decade hiatus. Participation in the 2024 IWWF World Cable Wakeboard Championships is mandatory for riders aspiring to secure one of the limited qualifying cable wakeboard spots available to compete in [The World Games 2025](#), in Chengdu, China. There will only be 15 spots allocated for men and 15 spots allocated for women to be part of these multi-sports games. Detailed information will be circulated shortly.
