5. ENTRY AND ADMINISTRATION (New Rule 14:12)

Each Federation shall declare, through EMS, not later than 60 days before the scheduled start of the first event of the World Championships:

- The names of the members of its team
- The names of the competitors entered as **"Individuals"**
- The names of the competitors entered as Wild Cards
- The names of the Official reserves.

For each competitor registered, the events that they will compete in together with the ramp height for Jump need to be entered.

An entry is considered complete when the Skier's name is registered in EMS and the full Entry Fee Payment has been received.

All payments need to be made by Credit Card/PayPal through EMS. For the Official Reserves, no payment is due at this time.

Any skier entered as a Wild Card or Individual is also to be considered to be a TEAM reserve.

An entered skier may be replaced by a different one without penalty, provided that they have already been entered as a Reserve skier, wild card or individual.

The 60 days deadline does not include those skiers who may additionally qualify **as individuals** through the Weekly or the Pro Ranking List (If applicable). For those skiers the following deadlines apply:

- 1) The deadline to enter skiers who qualify under the Weekly Ranking List is 30 days before the Championships.
- 2) The deadline to enter skiers who qualify under the Pro Tour Ranking List is 15 days before the Championships.

a) Fines for Late Registration.

Any Federation not meeting the registration deadlines will not be allowed to compete until their Federation pays a fine to the IWWF E&A Representative at the Championships. The fines are as follows:

- * **€ 25** per skier if the registration is made between 59 and 45 days before the scheduled start of the first event of the Championships
- * **€ 50** per skier if the registration is made between 44 to 30 days before the scheduled start of the first event of the Championships



- * **€ 75** per skier if the registration is made between 29 to 15 days before the scheduled start of the first event of the Championships
- * **Double the Entry Fee** per skier if the registration is made between 14 days until 12:00 (competition local time), 2 days before the scheduled start of the first event of the Championships
Example: scheduled start of the first event of the Championships is July 31 deadline to register skier is noon 12:00 UTC of July 29.

Two days before the start of the first event the entry lists shall be closed at noon 12:00 (competition local time) and thereafter the order of competitors entered and paid will be finalized and posted.

The Scorer in consultation with the Chief Judge should post Preliminary Running Orders 7 days preceding the start of events with the orders clearly marked as "Preliminary and subject to change". No change in this order is allowed after noon (competition local time) of the two days preceding the start of events except that a team representative may without penalty:

- 1) Withdraw a skier from the competition.
- 2) Replace an injured skier with a qualified official reserve from the same team with the authority of the Chief Judge and before the start of the first event, that is, before the first skier taking part in the first event has started.
- 3) The substitute skier shall start first in the series in which he is qualified unless the draw has not yet been completed.

b) Team or individual athletes not showing up:

In the event a team or individual athletes (for whom their Federation has submitted a competition entry), fail to show up for a competition their entry fee shall still be payable in full, unless a valid written excuse is received by 12 noon of two days before the start of the competition.

A valid excuse may include a sickness certificate or a certificated injury and should be considered and agreed as valid by the IWWF E&A Representative at the Championships.

All fines have to be paid on-site to the IWWF E&A Representative at the Championships. No skiers will be allowed to start if any due fine is not paid.

If the "valid excuse" is accepted, the money will be refunded by the Organiser to the relative Federation, within 30 days after the end of the competition.

Official Entry And Entry Fee

The Entry Fee for the 2025 IWWF E&A YOUTH Waterski Championships is **€220,00 per competitor** regardless of discipline.

6. OFFICIAL SITE FAMILIARIZATION (E&A Rule 14:07)

The last two or three days immediately before the Championships will be reserved and used for Official Familiarisation. This will be organized so that each competitor who has paid shall be allocated either a set number of passes and/or a certain amount of time at the discretion of the Chief Judge based on the principle that every skier shall receive an equal opportunity for familiarisation.

Slalom skiers will receive – 4 passes or 6 minutes whichever is less
Tricks skiers will receive – 2 passes or 5 minutes whichever is less
Jump skiers will receive – 3 passes or 6 minutes whichever is less

After closure of the ITE 60 days before the Championships each entered competitor will be allocated Official Familiarisation time as specified above. 45 days before the scheduled start of the event, the Organiser (in consultation with the Chief Judge, whose decision shall be final) shall announce the official familiarisation schedule (including the allowed time).

If a Federation does not want to take part in the Official Familiarisation, it must notify the Organisers and the Chief Judge as soon as possible. Time will be scheduled for competitors on a random team basis, and shall be grouped by event. Slalom familiarisation, Trick familiarisation and Jump familiarisation (by jump height) will be grouped together. Any athlete whose time has not been paid for at least 30 days before the scheduled start of the event, or who is not ready to ski in accordance with the schedule, will lose their official familiarisation time.

The Chief Judge shall have the discretion to change the start time of team's familiarisation based on extraordinary circumstances.

During the Official Familiarisation period the Chief Judge may allocate any available site familiarisation times but only to skiers who have not already used it or do not have time allocated.

The maximum cost per hour for Official familiarization will be €240,00 (€4,00 per minute)

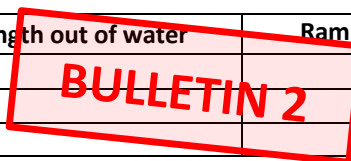

15. IWWF SAFE SPORT POLICY AND IWWF SAFEGUARDING REGULATIONS

We take safeguarding extremely seriously and are committed to ensuring that everyone who attends the championships, whether athletes, officials or volunteers are able to operate in a safe environment, free from abuse and the risk of harm. It is a condition of participation that all attendees familiarize themselves and comply with the IWWF Safeguarding Regulations which are available at <https://iwwf.sport/safe-sport-information/>

In particular initiations of new team members are no longer permitted. This does not stop the acknowledgement and welcoming of new team members.

16. LOCAL CURRENCY

The local currency in Spain is Euro. At most local stores and restaurants, you can pay with all the major credit cards.

17. FLAGS AND ANTHEMS

Each team must bring an additional flag of their country. (Size approximately 100x150cm)

All teams are also requested to bring a CD (or MP3) of their national anthem you will greatly help us if you send it to info@botaski.com

18. TRANSPORTATION

It is the responsibility of each team to arrange their own transportation to the site and between it and their chosen hotel for each day of the competition.

If the team is unable to do this, then the organizer will endeavor to make the necessary arrangements at a cost.



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19. PARKING AND SKI STORAGE

The organization will supply storage for competitors equipment.

Whilst security staff will be on site, the organization is not responsible for equipment that is lost or damaged.

20. HOW TO ENTER THE COUNTRY

A proof of identity and a valid travel document is required to enter Spain

Nationals of third States who travel to Spain for stays of up to 90 days (during any period of 180 days) for tourism, business, family visits, medical treatment, study, non-work internships or volunteer activities with a duration not exceeding 3 months, or for other non-gainful activities, must meet the entry conditions established in the Schengen Borders Code.

I am in good physical and mental health and I am physical capable of competing and participating, and fully competent to participate and compete, as a competitor in the Championships and that i have not been certified and/or advised otherwise by any qualified medical practitioner;

I do hereby authorize any and all physicians, paramedics and other medical personnel and practitioners procured by, or on behalf of, the IWWF and the Organizer to administer first aid treatment, or any medical treatment, surgery or transportation in the event of any illness, accident or injury suffered and/or sustained by me at any time during my participation and competition in the Championships (or any part thereof) and hereby indemnify, and shall keep fully and effectively indemnified, the IWWF and the Organizer (including all directors, officers, employees, volunteer and other representatives thereof) upon demand from and against any and all claims, liabilities, demands, costs and expenses of whatsoever nature incurred and/or suffered by the same (or any of them) and arising from, and/or in connection with, the procurement and administration of such medical treatment and transportation in relation to any such illness accident or injury suffered and/or sustained by me;
