3. THE SITE



The IWWC was founded in 1980 and moved to the lake in Gross-Enzersdorf in 1990. The lake is situated just outside the limits of Vienna, about 20 kilometers from the heart of the city. Average temperature in August is 25 degrees, the water temperature is usually about the same. The European Senior Waterski Championships took place here in 2002.

Please note:

For the slalom event an **8-buoy course** is installed due to the short length of the lake; the “0”-buoy (buoy #5 from the other direction) can be submerged automatically which makes the course ski like a regular 6-buoy course.



Accessibility of the site:

Car: From downtown Vienna the journey by car takes about 30 minutes (21 km).

Train: The closest train station “Raasdorf” is about 2 km from the site.

Public transport: Vienna’s subway line U2 ends 4 km from the site (directly at hotel Dormero), from there a public bus brings you 2 km closer

Airplane: Driving from Vienna International Airport to the site takes about 40 minutes (30 km).

Uber/Taxi: You can order a taxi/Uber from Vienna to the lake.

5. ENTRY AND ADMINISTRATION (New Rule 14:12)

Each Federation shall declare, through EMS, not later than 60 days before the scheduled start of the first event of the World Championships:

- The names of the members of its team
- The names of the competitors entered as “**Individuals**”
- The names of the competitors entered as Wild Cards
- The names of the Official reserves.

For each competitor registered, the events that they will compete in together with the ramp height for Jump need to be entered.

An entry is considered complete when the Skier's name is registered in EMS and the full Entry Fee Payment has been received.

All payments need to be made by Credit Card/PayPal through EMS. For the Official Reserves, no payment is due at this time.

Any skier entered as a Wild Card or Individual is also to be considered to be a TEAM reserve.

An entered skier may be replaced by a different one without penalty, provided that they have already been entered as a Reserve skier, wild card or individual.

The 60 days deadline does not include those skiers who may additionally qualify **as individuals** through the Weekly or the Pro Ranking List (If applicable). For those skiers the following deadlines apply:

- 1) The deadline to enter skiers who qualify under the Weekly Ranking List is 30 days before the Championships.
- 2) The deadline to enter skiers who qualify under the Pro Tour Ranking List is 15 days before the Championships.

a) Fines for Late Registration.

Any Federation not meeting the registration deadlines will not be allowed to compete until their Federation pays a fine to the IWWF E&A Representative at the Championships. The fines are as follows:

- * **€ 25** per skier if the registration is made between 59 and 45 days before the scheduled start of the first event of the Championships
- * **€ 50** per skier if the registration is made between 44 to 30 days before the scheduled start of the first event of the Championships
- * **€ 75** per skier if the registration is made between 29 to 15 days before the scheduled start of the first event of the Championships
- * **Double the Entry Fee** per skier if the registration is made between 14 days until 12:00 (competition local time), 2 days before the scheduled start of the first event of the Championships

Example: scheduled start of the first event of the Championships is July 31 deadline to register skier is noon 12:00 UTC of July 29.

Two days before the start of the first event the entry lists shall be closed at noon 12:00 (competition local time) and thereafter the order of competitors entered and paid will be finalized and posted.

The Scorer in consultation with the Chief Judge should post Preliminary Running Orders 7 days preceding the start of events with the orders clearly marked as “Preliminary and subject to change”. No change in this order is allowed after noon (competition local time) of the two days preceding the start of events except that a team representative may without penalty:

- 1) Withdraw a skier from the competition.
- 2) Replace an injured skier with a qualified official reserve from the same team with the authority of the Chief Judge and before the start of the first event, that is, before the first skier taking part in the first event has started.
- 3) The substitute skier shall start first in the series in which he is qualified unless the draw has not yet been completed.

b) Team or individual athletes not showing up:

In the event a team or individual athletes (for whom their Federation has submitted a competition entry), fail to show up for a competition their entry fee shall still be payable in full, unless a valid written excuse is received by 12 noon of two days before the start of the competition.

A valid excuse may include a sickness certificate or a certificated injury and should be considered and agreed as valid by the IWWF E&A Representative at the Championships. All fines have to be paid on-site to the IWWF E&A Representative at the Championships. No skiers will be allowed to start if any due fine is not paid.

If the “valid excuse” is accepted, the money will be refunded by the Organiser to the relative Federation, within 30 days after the end of the competition.

6. OFFICIAL ENTRY AND ENTRY FEE

The Entry Fee for the 2025 IWWF E&A Under 21 Waterski Championships is € 230,00 per competitor regardless of discipline. € 40.00 per skier will be deducted to assist technical officials with their travel costs and € 10.00 per skier will be deducted for the WADA Fund.

Remitting parties are responsible for ALL fees or charges at both ends. Where bank charges or fees have been deducted, Federations/Skiers will be required to make good any shortfall at registration.

Federation's skier's places in the draw shall be determined by the Chief Judge without reference to their qualifying scores.

7. OFFICIAL SITE FAMILIARIZATION (E&A Rule 14:07)

The last two days immediately before the Championships will be reserved and used for Official Familiarization. This will be organized so that each competitor who has paid shall be allocated either a set number of passes and/or a certain amount of time at the discretion of the Chief Judge based on the principle that every skier shall receive an equal opportunity for familiarization.

Slalom skiers will receive – 4 passes or 6 minutes whichever is less

Tricks skiers will receive – 2 passes or 5 minutes whichever is less

Jump skiers will receive – 3 passes or 6 minutes whichever is less

After closure of the ITE 60 days before the Championships each entered competitor will be allocated Official Familiarization time as specified above. 45 days before the scheduled start of the event, the Organizer (in consultation with the Chief Judge, whose decision shall be final) shall announce the official familiarization schedule (including the allowed time).

If a Federation does not want to take part in the Official Familiarization, it must notify the Organizers and the Chief Judge as soon as possible. Time will be scheduled for competitors on a random team basis, and shall be grouped by event. Slalom familiarization, Trick familiarization and Jump familiarization (by jump height) will be grouped together. Any athlete whose time has not been paid for at least 30 days before the scheduled start of the event, or who is not ready to ski in accordance with the schedule, will lose their official familiarization time.

The Chief Judge shall have the discretion to change the start time of team's familiarization based on extraordinary circumstances.

During the Official Familiarization period the Chief Judge may allocate any available site familiarization times but only to skiers who have not already used it or do not have time allocated.

The maximum cost per hour for official familiarization will be € 240,- (€ 4,- per minute)

I am in good physical and mental health and I am physical capable of competing and participating, and fully competent to participate and compete, as a competitor in the Championships and that i have not been certified and/or advised otherwise by any qualified medical practitioner;

I do hereby authorize any and all physicians, paramedics and other medical personnel and practitioners procured by, or on behalf of, the IWWF and the Organizer to administer first aid treatment, or any medical treatment, surgery or transportation in the event of any illness, accident or injury suffered and/or sustained by me at any time during my participation and competition in the Championships (or any part thereof) and hereby indemnify, and shall keep fully and effectively indemnified, the IWWF and the Organizer (including all directors, officers, employees, volunteer and other representatives thereof) upon demand from and against any and all claims, liabilities, demands, costs and expenses of whatsoever nature incurred and/or suffered by the same (or any of them) and arising from, and/or in connection with, the procurement and administration of such medical treatment and transportation in relation to any such illness accident or injury suffered and/or sustained by me;

As a member of a National Federation affiliated to the International Waterski & Wakeboard Federation and a participant in an event authorized or recognized by the International Waterski & Wakeboard Federation, I hereby declare as follows:

1. I acknowledge that I am bound by, and confirm that I shall comply with, all of the provisions of the IWWF Anti-Doping Rules (as amended from time to time), the World Anti-Doping Code (the "Code") and the International Standards issued by the World Anti-Doping Agency, as amended from time to time, and published on WADA's website.
2. I consent and agree to the creation of my profile in the WADA Doping Control Clearing House ("ADAMS"), as requested under the Code to which IWWF is a Signatory, and/or any other authorized National Anti-Doping Organization's similar system for the sharing of information, and to the entry in my Doping Control, Whereabouts and Therapeutic Use Exemptions related data in such systems.
3. I agree that during the Event and for up to ninety (90) days thereafter as may be needed for follow up testing, I will be subject to blood and/or urine testing for any substance or method on the World Anti-Doping Agency ("WADA") Prohibited List: https://www.wada-ama.org/sites/default/files/resources/files/2022list_final_en.pdf
4. I acknowledge the authority of IWWF [and its member National Federations and/or National Anti-Doping Organizations] under the IWWF Anti-Doping Rules to enforce, to manage results under, and to impose sanctions in accordance with the IWWF Anti-Doping Rules.
5. I acknowledge and agree that any dispute arising out of a decision made pursuant to the IWWF Anti-Doping Rules, after exhaustion of the process expressly provided for in the IWWF Anti-Doping Rules, may be appealed exclusively as provided in Article [13] of the IWWF Anti-Doping Rules to an appellate body for final and binding arbitration, which in the case of International-Level Athletes is the Court of Arbitration for Sport (CAS).
6. I acknowledge and agree that the decisions of the arbitral appellate body referenced above shall be final and enforceable, and that I will not bring any claim, arbitration, lawsuit or litigation in any other court or tribunal.
