b. Change of veteran age categories according to new European Veteran Circuit rules (FIN)

NFU decided to change of veteran age categories according to the European Veteran Circuit rules as follow.



All fencers must fence in the Age Category of the year of the announcement from the beginning of the fencing season, even if this means fencing in the older category at the end of the previous year.

V1: 40 - 49 years (a 39 year old fencer can participate if the championship is after summer)

V2: 50 - 59 years (a 49 year old fencer can participate if the championship is after summer)

V3: 60 - 69 years (a 59 year old fencer can participate if the championship is after summer)

V4: 70+ years (a 69 year old fencer can participate if the championship is after summer)

In the Veteran Nordic Championship in Malmö 2020, the organizer can decide either to use the old rules or the new rules according to the European Veteran Circuit rules.

c. Possibilities for common training camps in 2020 (SWE)

The training camp in January in Denmark is very popular. Mr. Jan Sylvest Jensen will check the possibility for more participants from NFU and give feedback as soon as possible.

There is a training camp in Haapsalu 27-29 march (before the World Championships for junior and cadets)

Mr. Margus Hanson will check the dates for other camps in Estonia and give feedback.
